

- Be a persistent and reliable conduit for introductions and linking people with others, groups, and activities in relation to environmental sustainability
- Identify and share best practice in relation to environmental sustainability
- Engage and involve people, agencies, and partners so that people feel they can influence decision making and that their voice is important.
- Be a "go to" person for information, support, and volunteering opportunities in environmental sustainability.
- Advocate volunteering by sharing best practice and supporting people to access local opportunities.
- Promote opportunities for social action including encouraging environmental sustainability champions
- Coordinate the steering group and work with key partners such as CVS South Gloucestershire and West of England Rural Network
